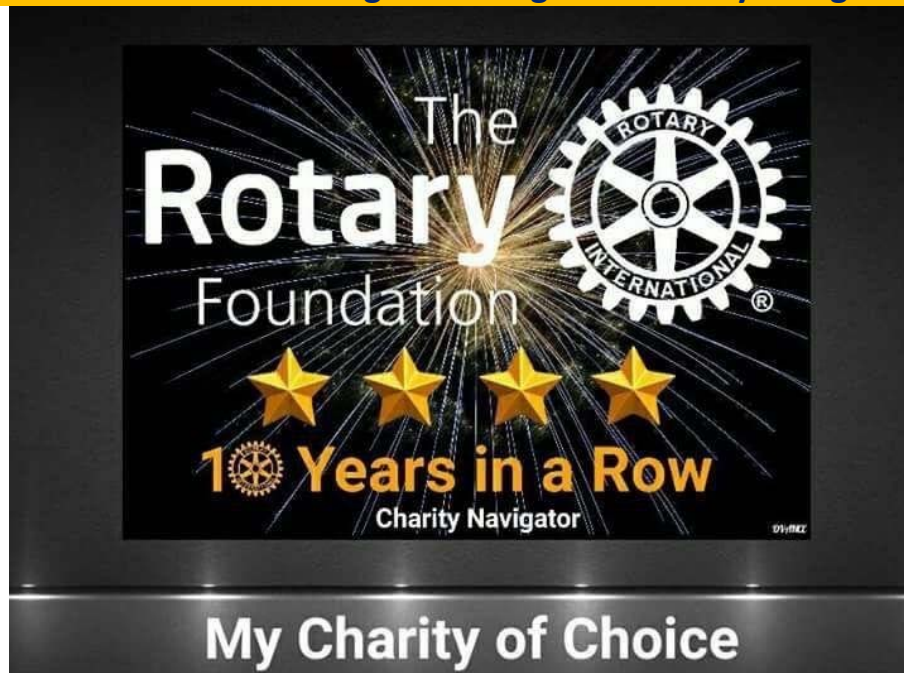
In 2019, the Rotary International Convention will travel to Hamburg, Germany. Registration is now open! With so much to see and do, the convention is an experience you won't want to miss
