If you haven't yet worked this year, this would be a great time to demonstrate Service Above Self and earn a make-up at the same time.



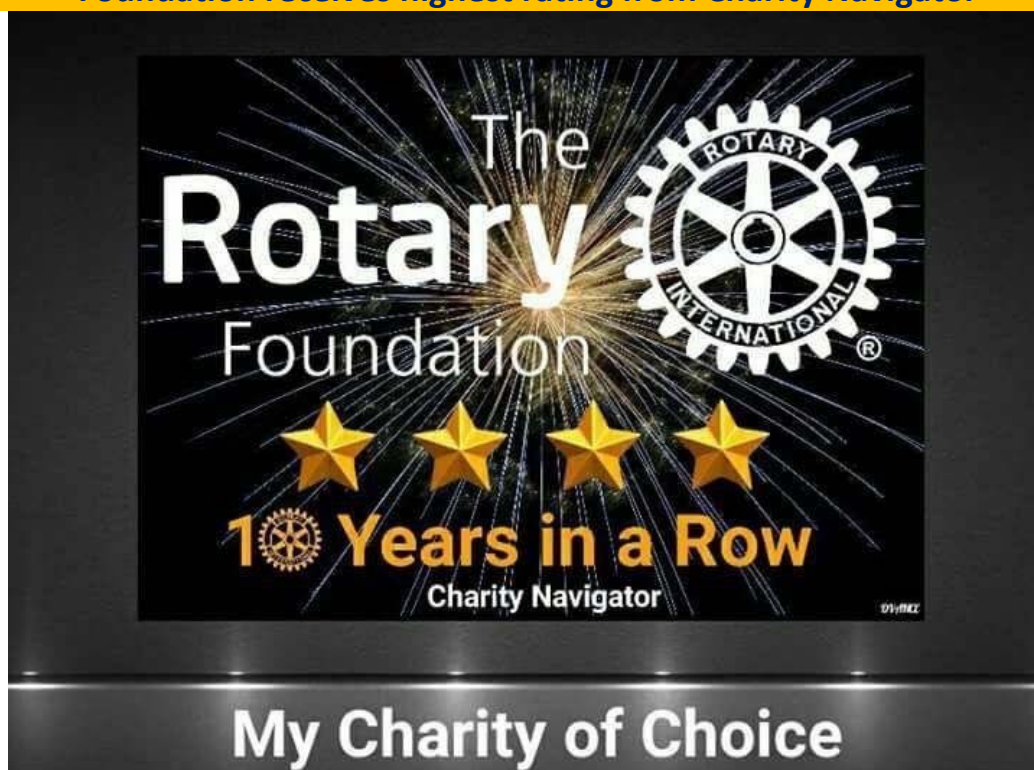


